

# INVITATION

## Nike Wrestling Girls Team Cup 2026

<b>Date:</b>	Saturday, 24.10.2026
<b>Venue:</b>	Sportshall NMS Klaus, Treietstraße 17b, 6833 Klaus
<b>Weigh-In:</b>	09.00 – 09.30 a.m. on two scales (all teams must bring completed weigh-in sheets and wrestling licenses for all team members)
<b>Start:</b>	10.30 a.m.
<b>Team Size:</b>	Maximum of 10 wrestlers per team
<b>Weight Categories:</b>	27-30 kg, 36 kg, 42 kg, 48 kg, 54 kg, 62 kg

Each team must field at least **5 wrestlers per match**.

A maximum of **one athlete per match** who does not hold the citizenship of the region represented by the team may be used. In addition, **one guest wrestler** ("loan wrestler") from the same country may be used per match.

Each athlete must compete in the weight category corresponding to her body weight at the official weigh-in. However, she may also move up by **one weight category**. For example, an athlete weighing **31.50 kg** must normally compete in the **36 kg** category but may also be entered in the **42 kg** category.

**Eligibility:** Only **regional teams** from their respective countries may participate in this championship (for example: Western Austria, Eastern Austria, Lower Bavaria). **Individual clubs and national teams are not permitted.** The region must be specified when submitting the official entry.

Eligible athletes are those who are holding a valid wrestling license issued by their home country and are born between 2009 and 2017.

**Competition Rules:** The competition will be conducted according to the **international UWW competition rules**.

**Awards:** Each participating team will receive medals, prizes in kind and a team trophy.

**Entries:** **Entries must be submitted no later than Monday, September 30, 2026 to Elena Pittl (service@ringsport.at, Handy 0043/660/57 87 003).** Participating teams are only required to submit the numbers of teams and the team name. No individual athlete registration is required.

**Entry Fee:** **€ 150,00 per Team** (maximum 10 wrestlers)  
**Late entries** are possible until Wednesday, October 21, 2026 for a fee of **€ 250,00**.

**Accommodation:** Accommodation arrangements and costs are the responsibility of the teams / regions. (Contact information for accommodations: Ritter Bernd, sportleitung@sk-klaus.at, Handy +43 699 16245491).

**Tournament Format:** The draw will take place on-site immediately before the competition. With 5 teams, the competition will be conducted in a round-robin format. With 6 or more teams, a pool system will be used. With 6 or more teams, matches will be held on two mats.

The team lineup for the next match must be submitted no later than five minutes after the final bout of the previous match.

**Anti-Doping:** Anti-doping controls may be conducted during this championship. By participating in this competition, athletes agree to comply with the anti-doping provisions of the Austrian Anti-Doping Federal Act 2021, as well as the relevant regulations of the competent national federation (ÖRSV) and the international governing body (UWW).
